



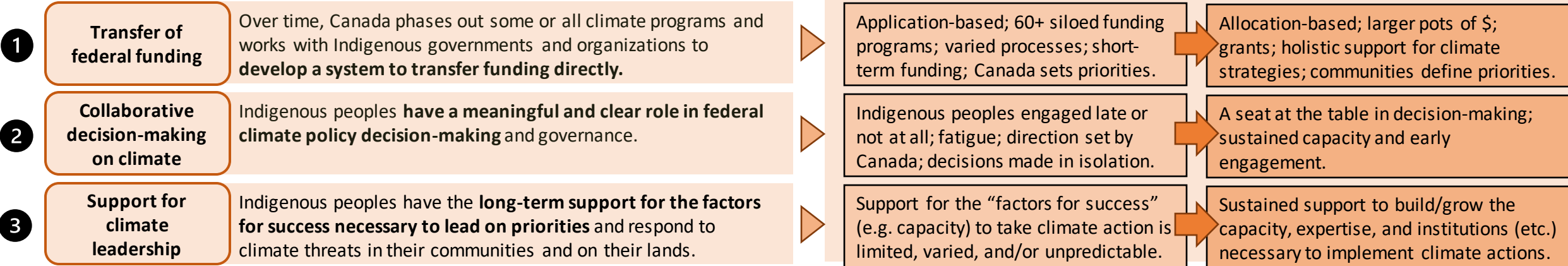
CO-DEVELOPING AN INDIGENOUS CLIMATE LEADERSHIP AGENDA

Overall Objective

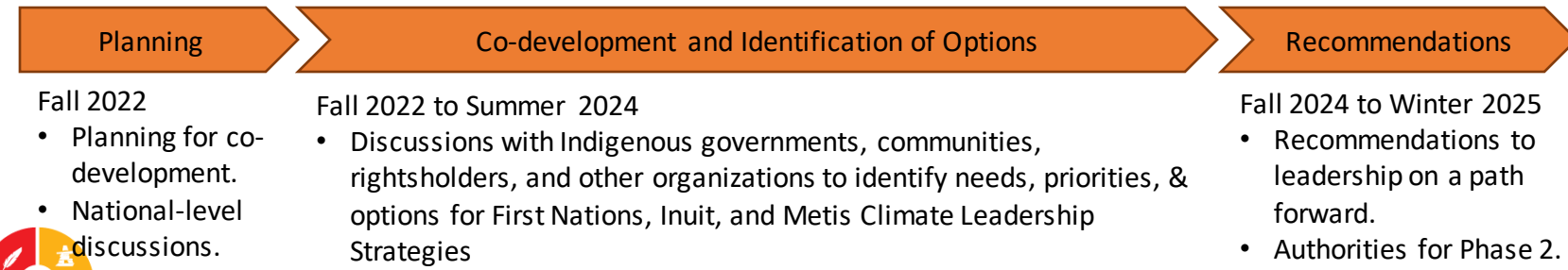
